### Overview:

The HFC Travel Soccer program is designed to support kids who can benefit from advanced skills training and a longer playing season. Professional training and coaching is available from our staff including HS and college level coaches plus 5 Olympic Development Program (ODP) trainers. Kids tryout in May, practice through the summer, and play their first game in September. Games are played either in Harleysville or within approximately 30-60 minutes of the Harleysville area, with one game a weekend throughout the season.

### Commitment:

Travel Soccer players practice 1–2 times a week throughout the season. They learn advanced ball skills, game strategies, and offensive/defensive drills to help them excel at the game. These advanced skills help strengthen their natural athletic abilities and prepare them for school sports and beyond.



### Philosophy:

We strive to combine physical training with character-building skills while instilling a positive experience in all our players. They acquire a better understanding of the game and learn that competitiveness and sportsmanship go hand in hand. We encourage all boys and girls ages 7 to 17 to tryout for an HFC Travel team!
